Cuvée Kriek is a blend of three mixed fermentation beers of different ages, from both foudre and barriques. They were honoured to be able to use cherries directly from Friederiksdal in Denmark, the blended beer aged again on those. A homage to the great Krieks of Belgium, with full cherry, subtle almond flavours and a balanced acidity from their unique yeast culture.



Spectral Lore 2023

Holy Goat Brewing

5.5% Fruited Sour

Holy Goat refermented their base beer on 250g/l of Tayberries and an additional 80g/l of strawberries, both harvested around I2 miles from the brewery. Tayberries are a cross between raspberries and blackberries, named after the River Tay, which runs through their home of Dundee where these berries were first bred.



Grim Fandango

Holy Goat Brewing

6% Wild Ale

Holy Goat fermented their golden sour base beer with a mixed culture of Brettanomyces and resident microflora present on the skins of pineapples. After primary fermentation was complete, it was re-fermented and conditioned with 400l of pressed pineapple juice, molasses sugar and whole Ceylon cinnamon.

7.4% BA Flanders Red

Collab with Pastore Brewing. This Flanders Red style beer was fermented on Pinot Noir skins from grapes grown in Crouch Vale, Essex. After three months on the skins it was blended with stock beer aged in red wine barrels. The resultant blend was conditioned on IOOg/I of local Scottish redcurrants and third-use whole Frederiksdal sour cherries.




