Brew York Reveals New-look Cask Range

To mark Beer Day Britain, the York-based brewery unveils new cask beer designs and launches a brand-new beer – Fennec - made with British hops.

Brew York is now seven years old and has come a long way since the first brews back in 2016. Now with 60+ new beers released annually alongside the core range, the brewery is working on a design refresh across 2023 to visually differentiate new releases, special editions, rebrews and collaborations. The ranges will sit alongside the existing State of Mind range, which showcases bar-rel-ageing and other specialist processes. The core range will be renamed 'Signature'.

Brew York is working with United by Design, a York-based creative agency who the brewery has worked with from day one. Together they are refreshing the visual identity, and more clearly defining the designs to better showcase the various beer ranges. In doing this the aim is to lay some solid foundations for the next chapter of Brew York.

To mark Beer Day Britain, the brewery has revealed the first designs – the Signature cask beer range, including a new addition, 'Fennec' – a blonde beer made with British hops to both complement and complete the set.

With cask beer sales on the rise, the designs have been developed with a more traditional approach and the focus is on the beer style with some key descriptor words to help inform the choices made at the bar.

Head of Marketing Rachel Auty says "As we've seen our cask sales increase by 54% over the last I2-months it's timely that we have now added Fennec - an easy-drinking session blonde made with Fuggles and UK Cascade hops - alongside fresh branding which we hope really showcases the quality of the brews themselves. We're really proud of the huge range of beers we release and I'm excited to move to the next part of the rebrand as we work across our ranges."

This is just a taste of what's to come from Brew York over the following months as they continue this journey and slowly transition from the current designs to the new ones.

Stemming The Tide Of Brewery Closures



Bristol Craft Beer Festival

A slight change to the normal routine saw Rob attend BCBF on the Saturday afternoon session this year, instead of the Friday session that we tend to favour.

Heading into the weekend, the weather had really settled into summer heatwave mode, so shorts, hat and sunscreen were the order of the day. We arrived at just after llam to find an already mammoth queue for the sold-out session, but kudos to We Are Beer for opening bang on II.30am and getting everyone processed and glass in hand super-quickly.



The BCBF has a fabulous location on the quayside in the centre of the City, although it is rather reliant on decent weather, as the seating is all outdoors, organised in a semi-circle around the central music stage. Our only slight gripe with the Festival site is that the toilets are some distance from the bar areas, in their own separate compound.

The bars were setup across six large marquees, with the emphasis being very much focused on West Country breweries, complemented by a decent number of UK representatives from further afield, plus a handful of overseas guest breweries.

Highlights for us included UK festival favourites Amundsen, Little Monster, Sureshot, Holy Goat and Phantom.
