Taproom Review



Clevedon Brewery Taproom

Unit I, Tweed Road industrial Estate, Tweed Road, Clevedon, Somerset BS2I 6RR

Situated at the far end of Tweed Road Industrial Estate is Clevedon's best kept secret – Clevedon Brewery. The brewery was originally established in 2016, having had various names, including Red Kite and Glede. The original owners, Howard and Dawn Tucker, ran the brewery for a couple of years before it was sold to a group of six local members in 2019. After the resignation of four members in 2021 and 2022 Les & John Turner continued to run the brewery until their retirement in the Autumn of 2024, mainly as a "hobby" brewery serving quality beers to a growing number of local members.



The restrictions of the COVID pandemic came into full force in March 2020 and it was only when they began to be lifted that local residents were able to visit the brewery to collect their take-away beers to drink at home. As the restrictions eased further, they could to return to the taproom to sample the beers in a more traditional and social way.

In October 2024, the brewery was taken over by a group of I4 passionate local members under the leadership of Director, Kevin Baldwin, each investing a small sum in the business and assisted by the previous owners. This marks a new chapter for this local brewery, which is becoming known for its unique and flavourful beers. The local community, including the brewery's regular customers, are eagerly anticipating how the new management will enhance the brewery's legacy.

Taproom Review

All the people working in the brewery and taproom, behind the bar, brewing the beer and carrying out management and admin tasks, are unpaid volunteers, aiming to ensure that the brewery and its taproom offer a friendly and convivial atmosphere in its cosy surroundings. Indeed, from my observations, it's a very enthusiastic family, committed to ensuring the success of their business venture.



The team at Clevedon Brewery brew a great range of traditional beers, most of which are usually available on hand-pump at the brewery taproom. They are committed to producing high-quality craft beers that cater for a diverse range of palates, focusing on traditional brewing techniques and premium ingredients. From hoppy IPAs to smooth stouts and pale ales, there's something for everyone.

Clevedon Gold (3.9%) is a clean, golden pale ale, brewed with Progress and Green Bullet hops, giving a lightly-spiced fruit tang. Clevedon Best (4.0%) is an English-style best bitter, with a rich brown colour and blended with Brewers Gold and First Gold hops for a rounded feel and subtle bitterness.
Clevedon Blonde (5.2%) is a triple-hopped blonde ale with a deep gold colour and a big hoppy taste, using Cascade, Williamette and Topaz hops, giving a good balance of bitterness and citrus flavours.
Clevedon IPA (5.0%) is a speciality pale English IPA using Brewers Gold and Boadicea hops for a subtle bittering, dry hopped with Challenger hops for a fruity nose. Clevedon BS2I (4.1%) is a deep golden pale ale, using Brewers Gold, Williamette and Celeia hops, giving a well-balanced fruit and floral finish.
Finally, Percy's Porter (4.4%) is a rich, dark coloured smooth porter, using Challenger and Williamette hops to complement the subtle vanilla undertones.

The pump clips all have a design featuring the historic Clevedon Pier and most of the beers are also available in bottled form. The design for Clevedon IPA even has a drawing of a miniature Taj Mahal on the pier, as homage to the original transport of IPA to India! The brewery itself utilises an 8-brewer's barrel kit, brewing half brews twice or three times a month. There are a handful of volunteer brewers, all being trained by the previous owners.

Taproom Review

At the moment, the Clevedon Brewery is unquestionably a small-scale business, with a small and friendly taproom, supplemented by an outside courtyard during the summer months. There's a monthly quiz night on Sunday and occasional live music, and the management team are hoping to expand gradually, setting up an on-line shop and engaging in local events outside the brewery, including local markets and festivals. It's hoped to have a summertime beer festival, before eventually making their beers available in other micro-pubs, bars and local shops.





If you're a fan of traditional craft beer and looking to explore hidden gems in the brewing scene, then look no further than Clevedon. When we visited at the end of November 2024, we found it to be one of the most welcoming and friendliest taprooms we've ever been to, drinking real beer with real people, and remembering that great beer is always worth talking about.

The tap room is usually open on Thursdays (I600–I900), Fridays (I600–2100), Saturdays (I400–2100) and Sundays (I400–I800). Brewery visits are available and private functions can be accommodated.

The taproom is situated in an industrial estate in the suburbs of Clevedon, just off Strode Road. It's not far from the Asda Clevedon supermarket on Southern Way, which is served by the X6 & X7 Badgerline buses. And although Clevedon Brewery beers are not yet available in local pubs, the Fallen Tree micropub in Hill Road is also worth a visit if you're in Clevedon.



Featured brewery Simple Things Fermentations




Established in Glasgow's Southside back in 2019, Simple Things Fermentations is owned and run by Phil Sisson (right) with brewing and production duties handled by Ewan Cockburn.

STF celebrated their 5th birthday with a re-brew of Smoked Rye Porter, the first beer to have been created on their 6hl kit, and other recent releases include a Peated Brown Ale, Red IPA and Scottish Light, AKA 60 Shilling.

The early years of the brewery's life coincided with lockdowns and the related variations and departures from established routes to market, which of course helped to shape the business.



Featured brewery: SimpleThings Fementations



A focus on small pack - bottles at first before a move into cans - meant the original vision to explore some of the less well represented styles quickly found a wide audience. Among the early favourites were Scottish Export, Foreign Extra Stout, Table Saison and Wheat Wine and support came from local institutions such as Wee Beer Shop and Valhalla's Goat as well as independent beer specialists further afield including Beermoth, House of Trembling Madness, Stirchley Wines and Ghost Whale.

As business grew and the world began to return to something approaching normal, STF evolved to include the more mainstream lagers and hoppy pales in their range, maintaining natural carbonation across the board as a key point of difference, and with keg and cask sales to the on-trade playing an increasingly important role.

"It hasn't been an easy few years for anyone" comments Phil, "but keeping things small and tight, with a clear focus on quality and doing things a bit differently has worked well for us. We keep on steadily growing and have just installed three new tanks. Last year we added Rufus, a hazy, hoppy 4% Extra Pale, and Tenements, a 3.8% gluten-free Lager to the keg range, and Toledo, which is a modern pale ale that we're doing just for cask. The new tanks will help us keep up with demand for those, and do a bit more of everything else too. "

Featured brewery: SimpleThings Fementations



Besides the regular releases there's a modest mixed ferm and barrel ageing side project, which over the past I2 months has produced the highly rated Vatted Stout and Old Red, an Old Ale collab with Sunken Knave. There's also a fledgling hot sauce operation, currently to be found only at festivals but – along with the rest of the STF enterprise – with ample scope for scaling up.

The brewery is housed in a Victorian-era workshop unit originally built as a bakery, in a residential area, which means there will be no STF taproom until such time as the steady growth allows a move to a bigger premises. Until then, the beers are popping up and being enjoyed in Glasgow, Edinburgh and beyond with increasing regularity and Phil and Ewan will keep quietly marching on, fighting the good fight.
