A Taxing Year

Yesterday marked the start of the new UK tax year. The seemingly odd date of April 6th dates back to medieval times and is a result of historical tax collection practices.

Originally, New Year in England began on March 25th (Lady Day), aligning with the Feast of the Annunciation. At the time, the Julian calendar was in use, but in I752, Britain switched to the Gregorian calendar, moving New Year to January Ist while keeping the tax year starting on March 25th.

The Julian calendar was slightly longer than a solar year, causing a gradual misalignment. By I752, England was II days out of sync, so those days were dropped from September to realign. To prevent tax revenue loss, the Treasury extended the tax year by adding back the II days plus one extra for a leap year—hence, April 6th!

Enough tax talk—I could really use a strong craft ale or three!



Last Saturday, Emma and Steve from TWICB spent an enjoyable afternoon at the Chelmsford Social Club, attending the second annual Chelmsford Craft Beer Festival.

Organised by Hopsters—well-known for their craft beer establishments in Leigh-on-Sea, lpswich, Woodbridge, Felixstowe, and Chelmsford—this event promised a delicious experience for craft beer lovers.



Choosing the Saturday afternoon session, we entered the venue after paying a modest £5 entry fee. Inside, we were welcomed by a lively crowd of around 200 attendees, filling the intimate yet comfortable space with an unmistakable buzz of excitement.

The festival operated on a simple token system, with tokens available for purchase at the door in £IO increments. This hassle-free approach made it easy to sample a variety of offerings from the participating craft breweries during the five-hour session.

Festival Review

Though small, the brewery lineup was exceptional. Featuring Duration Brewing, The Kernel, Burnt Mill, Radio City Beer Works, Phantom Brewing, Three Hills, Time & Tide, Braybrook Beer, and Northdown Brewery, each showcased at least four unique brews. It was clear that breweries brought their latest and freshest creations, with few standard core beers in sight.





Expertly managed by Ed, the driving force behind Hopsters Events, the festival offered an outstanding tasting experience. A DJ kept the atmosphere lively with great music, while a kitchen kiosk served up simple yet satisfying food, ensuring a well-rounded event for all the senses.

The standout beer of the day was Plenty of Clouds by Phantom Brewing—a fantastic 8% DIPA—closely followed by Burnt Mill's magnificent BA imperial stout, The Weight of Brunch.

Hard plastic glasses were provided, proving to be a much better option than the flimsy ones often found at events where glasses are prohibited.





In conclusion, the Chelmsford Craft Beer Festival was a resounding success, providing a fantastic platform for local brewers to showcase their craft while fostering a strong sense of community among beer enthusiasts. We eagerly look forward to future editions and applaud the organisers for a job well done. Cheers to great beer and even better times!

Featured BreweryTurning Point Brew Co.

Turning Point Brew Co. have entered their seventh year with characteristic gusto. They're well embedded into both the brewery and the community in Knaresborough where they remain committed to two basic principles, the premise of which runs through everything they do - be it another huge and silly imperial stout or their flagship US Pale Disco King.

A brewery started in 2017 by two people quitting their day jobs to follow their passion for beer has never forgotten these simple goals set out from the beginning: Brewing their favourite beers and having a good time. In a climate riddled with challenges, Turning Point are well placed to continue to do both of those things in the coming months.

Fresh off the back of a huge IWCBD event, a collaboration with American pop punk band Bowling For Soup, and most recently "Imperial March" last weekend where Turning Point spread 7 Cask Imperial Stouts across 7 fantastic pubs in York for the day - there is plenty going on aboard Planet Turning Point.

First and foremost on this good (space) ship is the return of their annual Custard Sessions. This year, Friday 25th of April sees 54 venues across the UK join them in custard chaos – pouring three custard beers simultaneously and inviting patrons to "Conquer The Custard".

Turning Point Brew Co.

Never ones to shy from shooting for the moon, they've gone all out again this year. Alongside the original and completely sensible 6% Custard Pale Ale "Yellow Matter Custard" they have concocted its rhubarb counterpart named, would you believe, "Rhubarb Matter Custard". This extremely pink beer sees the usual lashings of vanilla custard paired with sweet and tangy rhubarb. It seemed only right, given Turning Point share West Yorkshire with the Rhubarb Triangle.



To complete the custard cohort, the question of how to match their previous Custard stout was one that had been on their minds since the Custard Sessions 2023 collaboration with Northern Monk. "Death Matter Custard" (A custard-ised iteration of "Death") along with a Barrel Aged version the following year was by far one of the most popular beers Turning Point have ever released.

This year Siren have joined them in the custard-sphere and with them they've married custard and cake. "Caribbean Matter Custard" sees Dark Matter fuse with Caribbean Chocolate Cake. The beer is II% of opulence featuring, of course, custard and vanilla along with Cacao, Chocolate, and those signature cyprus spirals. Launch locations are to be about to be released across their various online platforms.

Turning Point Brew Co.

Turning Point haven't gone entirely custard-crazy and have exciting things rumbling from the other end of the beer gamut. Co-founder Aron has been sitting on a recipe he's wanted to brew for a good few years and has decided that the time has come for an I895 Mild from the now defunct Malton Brewery Rose's to take the fore.

Teaming up with Five Points - who have brewed a partner beer from a recipe circa 1995 - between them brewed two IOO-year-apart impressions of a landmark style. With ingredients never before seen at Turning Point such as chevalier malt and Fuggles hops, both breweries have been very careful to create beers that are not just true to their inspirations - but a celebration of them too.



Speaking of celebrations, these beers will launch and pour side by side on Thursday April 24th at their pub The Falcon (York), and at Five Points' pubs The Pembury Tavern (London) and Whitelock's Ale House (Leeds).

In addition, April will see Turning Point open their Taproom again for the year on the 25th & 26th - followed by the last weekend of every month until September.

Turning Point will be pouring at Brew LDN, collaborating with Howling Hops, pairing their beer with crisps at Sheffield's Boston Arms, taking over the taps at Angel's Micropub in Belper, and looking forward to events in May at Sheffield's Hallamshire House, Newcastle's Elder Bar, Attic Barrel Store alongside an Attic Collaboration, and pouring at Chester Beer Festival too.


