Yet Another Bank Holiday

We've had four Bank Holidays in the past two months, which got me wondering when the tradition began. It turns out they originated in the I9th century with the UK's Bank Holiday Act of I87I. Introduced by Sir John Lubbock, it established four public holidays in England and Wales: Easter Monday, Whit Monday (May Day), the first Monday in August, and Boxing Day. Initially intended as a break for bank staff, these holidays gradually extended to businesses, schools, and government offices.

The original four have since grown to eight—though oddly, only one falls between June and November, with the other seven crammed between December and May.

Compared to the rest of the world, the UK isn't exactly flush with public holidays. Alongside the Netherlands, we have the fewest—Spain has I4, India 2I, and Nepal tops the list with 36 (though they also work six days a week!).

With only one more bank holiday left before Christmas, let's make the most of it—with some sensible enjoyment of delicious craft beers!



The eagerly anticipated weekend finally arrived, and the TWICB Team descended upon Manchester last Friday with high hopes and empty glasses, ready for round two of the Manchester Craft Beer Festival. But before diving into the festivities, we made a necessary pit stop at the fantastic Track Brewing Co Taproom—a vibrant and welcoming space where we warmed up with a few glasses of their ever-impressive pours.



This time around, Manchester graced us with glorious sunshine—an added bonus that made exploring the city on foot even more enjoyable as we made our way to Depot Mayfield, the venue for the festival.

Festival Review

Organised by We Are Beer, the Manchester Craft Beer Festival is one of three annual events alongside its sister festivals in Bristol and London. Like the others, this one follows an all-inclusive format: pay once (in this case, £60), get your souvenir glass, and sample to your heart's content. It's a format we love, encouraging exploration and risk-taking—after all, sometimes the beer you'd never normally choose becomes your surprise favourite.



Depot Mayfield proved to be an ideal venue: a large, open-plan warehouse with ample space and a dark, moody ambiance that somehow added to the buzz. Despite the crowds, the layout meant we never struggled to find seating or space to roam. The atmosphere was lively but never overwhelming, making it easy to relax and soak in the experience.



Festival Review

Across three well-attended sessions—Friday evening, Saturday afternoon, and Saturday evening—over 80 breweries showcased their best creations. With around 500 different beers on offer, there was truly something for everyone. While most breweries were from the UK, we did miss the presence of a few we'd been looking forward to, such as Overtone, Polly's Brew, and local favourite Track.

The event was elevated further by a superb selection of street food, offering perfect pairings for the diverse beers on tap. A rotating cast of DJs and a live band ensured the energy never dipped, creating a dynamic, festival-like feel that kept spirits high well into the evening.



In all, the Manchester Craft Beer Festival delivered on every level—great beer, great vibes, and a chance to discover new favourites in an unforgettable setting. Whether you're a seasoned beer geek or just looking for a fun weekend activity, this festival is a must-visit.

Strata Hops: The Modern Darling of Craft Brewing

In the ever-evolving world of craft beer, few hop varieties have made as dynamic an entrance as **Strata**. Bursting onto the scene in the late 20l0s, this versatile and flavour-packed hop has rapidly become a favorite among brewers looking to push boundaries and deliver bold, aromatic beers. Whether you're a seasoned brewer or just exploring the nuances of your favourite hazy IPA, Strata is a name worth knowing.

Origins of Strata

Strata was developed by **Indie Hops** in collaboration with Oregon State University's hop breeding program. It was first released commercially in **2018** after nearly a decade of development and trials. Originally known as X-33I, Strata was bred from an open-pollinated Perle mother, which means its male parent is unknown—adding a bit of mystery to its already complex profile.

Strata was specifically bred to meet the growing demand for new-world hops that could deliver intense flavour, aroma, and flexibility across beer styles, particularly the booming hazy IPA category.

Hop of the week: STRATA

Aroma and Flavour Profile

One of Strata's standout features is its multi-dimensional aroma and flavour profile, which balances fruit-forward notes with dank, herbal undertones. Its key characteristics include:


Strawberry and tropical fruit – ripe mango, passionfruit, and melon

Citrus – grapefruit zest and orange peel

Dankness – cannabis-like herbal funk (often described as "terpy" or "sticky")

Subtle earthiness – tea-like or herbal base notes

This unique combination makes Strata particularly well-suited for dry hopping and late-boil additions, where its complex aromas can really shine.

Brewing Applications

Strata is a hop for creative brewers. Its intense aromatics and layered flavour mean it works beautifully as a single-hop showcase, but it also plays well with others, especially citrusy and tropical varieties like **Citra, Mosaic, Simcoe, or Galaxy.**

Ideal Beer Styles:

Hazy IPAs / NEIPAs
Pale Ales
Double IPAs
Hoppy Lagers
Experimental or fruit-forward ales

Because of its strong personality, many brewers are using Strata to differentiate their brews in an increasingly crowded hop market.

Growing and Availability

Strata is primarily grown in the Pacific Northwest, especially in Oregon where it was bred. It's considered relatively hardy and productive, with a moderate to high alpha acid content (usually between II–I3%), which adds to its versatility. As demand grows, more acreage is being dedicated to Strata, making it increasingly accessible to homebrewers and commercial brewers alike.

Brewer and Consumer Reception

Craft beer fans often rave about Strata beers for their juicy, heady aromas and modern flavour combinations. On taproom menus, beers highlighting Strata often stand out, especially when brewers emphasize its "passionfruit meets pot" character—a nod to the hop's aromatic complexity.

Brewers, on the other hand, praise Strata for its consistency, impact, and uniqueness. It allows for creativity without sacrificing drinkability.

Conclusion

Strata is more than just a trendy hop; it's a powerful tool for brewers seeking to create standout beers with vibrant, layered flavour profiles. Whether leading the charge in a single-hop hazy IPA or adding depth to a hop blend, Strata brings a signature style that is unmistakably modern, delicious, and full of potential.

If you haven't brewed with—or tasted—a Strata-forward beer yet, it might just be time to see what all the hype is about.
